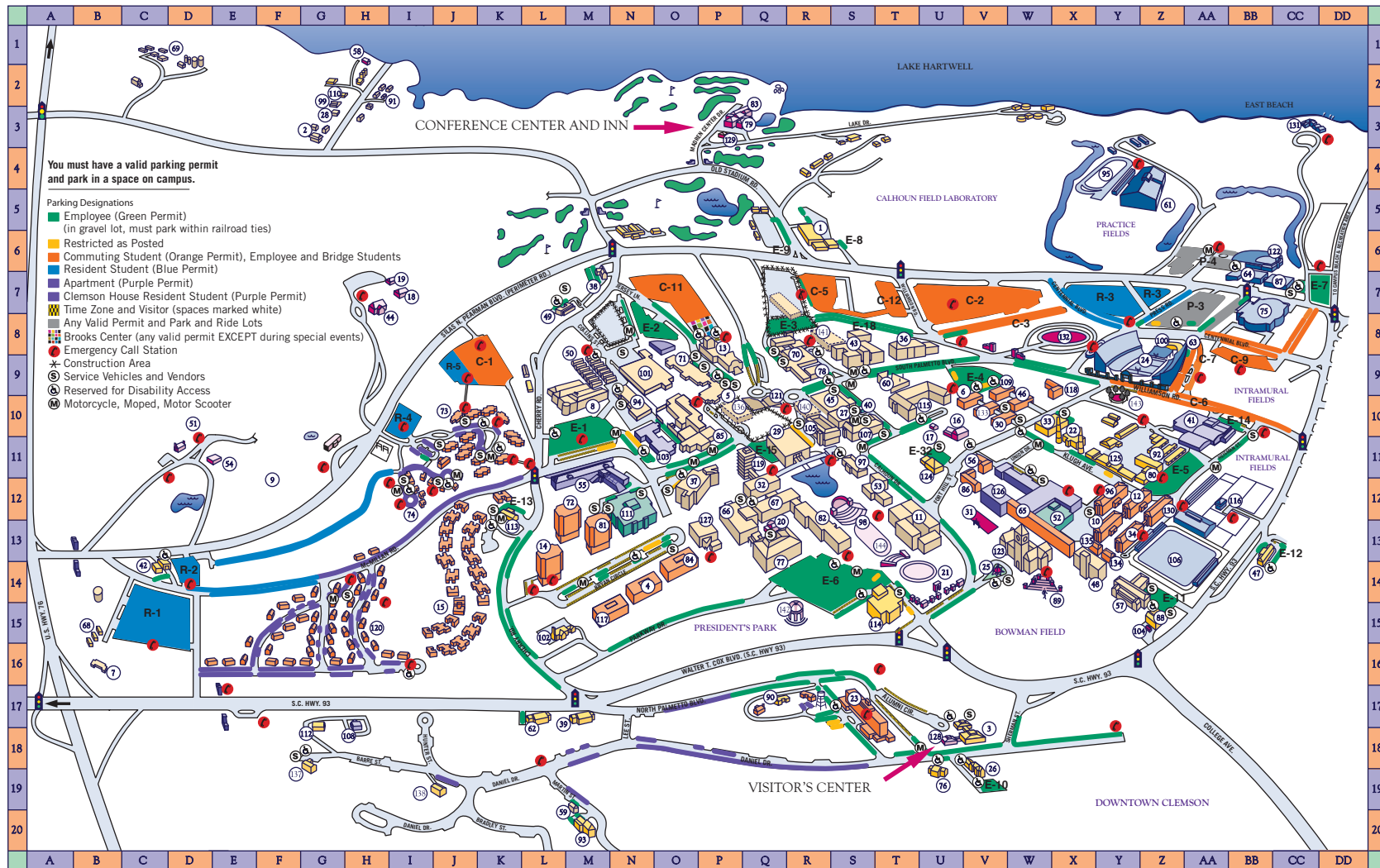


2011-2012 CLEMSON UNIVERSITY PARKING MAP



PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Everyone, including visitors, must obtain and display a parking permit to park anywhere on campus at any time. Short-term and temporary permits are available at Parking Services. Students that come to campus after hours or on weekends must obtain a permit from CUPD.
- Visitor spaces are reserved for visitors only except from 9 p.m. until 7 a.m. This includes paid metered visitor spaces with "VISITOR" stenciled in space.
- Resident students are authorized to park in unrestricted employee spaces from 7 p.m. until 7 a.m. (see parking regulations online for exceptions).
- Commuter students are authorized to park in unrestricted employee spaces from 4:30 p.m. until 7 a.m.
- Students are not authorized to park in 24-hour employee parking spaces at any time. Vehicles may be towed from these areas.
- Students are not authorized to park in service vehicle spaces at any time.
- Parking rules and regulations are enforced year-round, including breaks.
- A portion of the Brooks Center parking lot is reserved during special events (see designation in lot C-11). Brooks Center events can be found online at clemson.edu/brooks
- In the event that your vehicle breaks down in an unauthorized space or you need to load/unload near a building, you should contact Clemson University Police Department for special permission and assistance at 864-656-2222.
- If you park anywhere other than a marked space, your vehicle may be towed.
- Clemson operates under revised parking regulations on game days. *Inside Clemson* issues a special e-mail during the week of every home football game to outline applicable revisions.
- Timed spaces are enforced except between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m.
- The fine for parking in an accessible space without a permit (or with a permit that is not issued to you) is \$1,000. ADA permits must be registered with Parking Services. You must also display a valid Clemson University parking permit.
- If you or the vehicle has three or more citations over 15 days old, it can be towed at your expense.
